- All deadlines are **8:30 am**, unless otherwise stated.
- All DRAFT Assessment items require 1 copy and the summary page of the Turnitin report to be handed in to the IB office, unless otherwise stated.
- All FINAL Assessment items require 2 copies (plus signed copies of relevant cover sheets when applicable) and the summary page of the Turnitin report to be handed in to the **IB Office**, unless otherwise stated.
- The deadlines in this calendar are the **final dates** by which an assessment item (Draft and Final) must be handed in or completed. It is recommended that you submit these earlier. You will also be given various intermediate deadlines by your subject teacher for the completion of various initial drafts of your final IA work.
- All deadlines are **non-negotiable** and **immovable**. They are there to help you structure and plan your IB studies.
- All IAs and EAs involving research must observe the highest standards of academic honesty and be submitted via Turnitin.
- Group 4 interim due dates: all laboratory reports will be due one week after the completion of the practical work.
- Make copies of this deadline sheet to give to your parents and make sure that they are also aware of the deadlines that affect you.
- These deadlines form part of your overall IB assessment (including intermediate drafts, etc).
- If you are having difficulties, **do not wait till the last minute to do something about it**. If you are absent from school for any reason on the day of the above deadlines, the relevant deadline will be the last day you are in school **before** the absence.
- Make deadlines your friends – as mentioned above, they are there to help you. So are a lot of other people.
- This schedule is for official IB Internal and External Assessment tasks only. Your teachers will issue you with assessment programs for each subject showing the deadlines and method of aggregating marks for class tasks leading to school report marks.
