Semester 2 Examination Procedures

Students are responsible to ensure that they:

- have read and understood the Exam Timetable distributed
- comply with school policies regarding uniform and bags during the exams
- complete **QUIET** study in the Library/Study Hall if at school before or after an examination
- attend all co-curricular training sessions as normal

Lateness and absence for examinations:

- no extra time is awarded for lateness. Late students will complete the examination at the same time as all candidates.
- students who are absent:
 - **MUST** have their parent/guardian phone the school on the morning of their absence. Should the school not be informed of an absence for an examination, then parents will be contacted at our earliest convenience
 - **MUST** provide a medical certificate on the next day of attendance and sit the missed examination at the time advised.

Arrival to examinations

Students **MUST**:

- NOT enter the examination rooms until instructed to do so by staff
- be present outside exam venue 15 min before all examinations
- NOT leave bags IN THE CORRIDOR but leave in lockers as usual
- wear full school uniform and use the regulation school bag
- use the lift from the arcade to Level 5 for all morning examinations.

Procedures in the examination room:

Students **MUST**:

- **NOT** have electronic devices e.g. mobile phones, iPods, smartwatches etc., in their possession while sitting an examination. Mobile phones **MUST** be left in lockers or in the box placed in the front of the room. While exams are in progress these **MUST BE SWITCHED OFF**. Failure to do so may be deemed as 'Academic Misconduct'
- **Use a BLACK PEN** for all written answers
- Have their own equipment, esp. a calculator. **BORROWING IS NOT PERMITTED**
- **Have only water to drink** and this **MUST be in a clear bottle** on the desk
- Use a **clear** plastic pencil case which may be placed on the examination table
- **Sign** identity sheets for each exam and put their **student number** on all papers
- Not use the bathroom in a one hour examination or in the final half hour of an exam
- NOT SPEAK in the exam room and sit in their designated seat
- Remain for the entire examination time allocated for each examination.

Procedures for students accessing disability provisions for examinations

All students using **disability provisions** must do so in rooms allocated.
